Minutes

February 14, 2022

The regular monthly meeting of the Washington Township Planning and Zoning Committee was held February 14, 2022, in the Township Meeting Room on Welty Road at 1:30 p.m.

The following Committee members were present: Strausbaugh, Stine, DeDona, McCracken and McCleaf. The following people were also present: Township Planner Vernon Ashway, Township Manager Jeffrey Geesaman, Asst. Township Planner Chad Reichard, and Township Solicitor Zach Mills. Tim Cormany with Martin & Martin was also present.

Charles Strausbaugh called the meeting to order. There were no comments from the floor.

Organization of the Board:

Zoning Officer Ashway held nominations for Chairman of the P.C. board. On a McCleaf/DeDona motion, Strausbaugh was nominated and appointed as the Chairman of the Planning Committee. The vote was unanimous. Strausbaugh then held nominations for Vice Chairman. McCleaf was nominated on a DeDona/McCraken motion. The vote was unanimous. On a McCleaf/DeDona motion, McCracken was appointed as the Secretary of the Planning Committee. The vote was unanimous.

Other Business:

The agenda for the meeting was approved on a DeDona/McCleaf motion. The vote was unanimous.

The minutes of the November 8, 2021 meeting were also approved on a DeDona/McCleaf motion. The vote was unanimous.

A proposed Zoning and SALDO Ordinance Amendment from the Borough of Waynesboro to re-zone certain areas of the Borough from Industrial to Industrial/Commercial and eliminating the Industrial classification. Further amendment as proposed by the Borough would make changes to their sign ordinance. The Planning Committee had no comments on either change.

Additionally, a plan for a potential campground located near Pennersville Road was presented to the Planning Committee for informational purposes. No vote was taken.

Plot Plans:

O5-21 Pheasant Run Tick Ridge Road Final Sub-Division Plan: The plan was explained to the committee. The plan was recommended for approval with Conditions on a DeDona/McCracken motion. The vote was unanimous.

The conditions are that Bonding/Security be provided for public improvements and a phasing plan be created for future development.

- 26-21 Homes by Keystone Midvale Road Final Sub-Division Plan: The plan was explained to the committee. The plan was recommended for approval without conditions on a McCleaf/DeDona motion. The vote was unanimous.
- 01-22 Hondel Estates Harbaugh Church Road Final Sub-Division Plan: The plan was explained to the committee. The plan was recommended for approval without conditions on a McCleaf/DeDona motion. The vote was unanimous.
- 02-22 Farm Spring Estates Gopher Drive North Final Sub-Division Plan: The plan was explained to the committee. The plan was recommended for approval without conditions on a McCleaf/Stine motion. The vote was unanimous.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:12 p.m. by a McCleaf/DeDona motion. The vote was unanimous.
