**Red Run Express at Red Run Park:** The Red Run Express is scheduled to begin running this spring on Sunday, May 4, and will run every Saturday, Sunday and holiday between Memorial Day and Labor Day from 1 to 4 p.m., weather permitting and volunteers being available.

**Police Department:** The Washington Township Police Department is distributing free gun locks to encourage safe handling and storage practices of firearms. The distribution project to promote firearm safety is supported by a grant from the United States Department of Justice and managed by the National Shooting Sports Foundation.

The locks may be used on various types of firearms including rifles, revolvers, shotguns, and semi-automatic handguns. While the supply lasts, the Washington Township Police Department will provide free gunlocks to any member of the community.

MAY 10 - Fish Rodeo at Red Run Park: On Saturday, May 10, 9AM to 4PM, the Rouzerville Fish and Game Association will host its annual Fish Rodeo at Red Run Lake. Children ages 4 to 15 are permitted to fish.

Metal Detecting on Township Park Property: Please be advised that metal detecting is prohibited at all the township parks unless the individual obtains a "Metal Detecting Permit" from the township office. This permit must be displayed at all times while detecting at the parks. At the Battle of Monterey Pass Park no public metal detecting is permitted.
