In Memory of former Washington Township Supervisor Andrew Fitz: On Saturday, May 17, 2014, Andy Fitz passed away. Mr. Fitz served as a Township Supervisor for 7 years starting in 1969 and ending in 1977. He served as Chairman of the Board in years 1969, 1970, 1973 and Vice Chair in 1977.

Mr. Fitz contributed to many areas of the Township during his tenure.

When you see members of his family, thank them for all the good things that Mr. Fitz did for the Township.

Transfer Station Change – Starting in the middle of June the Township, as a result of a scale procedure review by the PA Department of Agriculture, is now required to place your vehicle tag (license plate number), name, and address on all weigh slips issued at the transfer station. As a result, when the program begins you will enter on to the scale, then unload your load, return to the scale, weigh out and then go to the scale house window for payment as you have done for years. What is new - while you are at the scale house window your weigh slip will be handed to you and you will be required to place your tag number; name and address on the top of the 3 part weigh slip.

Unfortunately, this new procedure will slow things down a little bit at the scale house.

Remember, the Department of Agriculture is requiring us to do this, not the “Township” so please do not take it out on the township employees.

There will be new signs erected along both sides of the roadway heading to the scale reminding you of the 3 new items you will need to do. Please try to remember your tag number.

This new procedure will not be required of bag or yard waste customers who do not use the scale.
