From the Supervisors - Proposed new Sidewalk Maintenance Ordinance: On August 13, starting at 7:00 PM at our workshop meeting at the township meeting room at 13013 Welty Road, we will take comments on the proposed new sidewalk maintenance ordinance. This ordinance regulates the maintenance of the two sidewalks in the township which are along N. Welty Road and Washington Township Boulevard. Maintenance includes snow removal.

Paving 2014: The Township will be opening bids on Monday, August 4th for a contractor to provide a double seal coat of stone and oil and one week later a fog coat over the seal coat. This is the same application that we put on Iroquois, Lenape Lane and part of Susquehanna Drive last year. The roads receiving double seal coat and fog seal are as follows: Barnett Ave., Geiser Ave., Strickler Ave., Landis Ave., Oller Ave., Hillcrest Ave., Highland Terrace, Twin Hill, Clearview Terrace, Blue Mountain Ave., Fish & Game Road, Candura Dr., Jacob Mack East, Jacob Mack West. (Fish & Game road is not going to receive a fog coat.) Once a contractor has been selected we will post a schedule of paving so residents know when they will be on each street.

Allergies to Paving Oil: If you have an allergy to paving oil and you live along any of the roadways listed above please contact the Township Manager, Mike Christopher at 762-3128 to discuss options that may be available to help mitigate your allergic reaction to the paving oil.

Red Run Lake: The Township has applied for the final permit to drain Red Run Lake starting the week of August 4th. Once the permit is obtained the public works department will drain the lake and let the sediment dry for a couple of weeks. Once the sediment dries it will be removed. Any fish in the lake will be removed and maintained by the Rouzerville Fish & Game Club.

WTMA News: Monterey Lane Sewerage Force Main Replacement Project. Starting the first week of August the WTMA's contractor, RIS Construction Group, will start work on replacing the force main from the pump station along Rt. 16 to Charmian Road. It is anticipated that the first month of construction will occur from the pump station to Martins Lane and should not have any impact on traffic on Monterey Lane. Once the contractor gets to Monterey Lane the roadway may be closed during the day for construction, or at the minimum, there will be one lane of traffic. More details on the contractor progress and traffic delays on Monterey Lane will be provided in next month's newsletter.
