Our Public Works Department did an outstanding job of removing the muck from the Lake, the Rouzerville Fish and Game folks did a great job of collecting the fish and storing them for us, Hudson's Mobile Welding and Fabrication did a great job of repairing the bridge and constructing the works for the new outlet structure.

The Lake repairs are now done, the outlet structure has been closed and the Lake is full of water again. The fish will be returned shortly. Once again we would like to thank everyone involved with this project.

CONDITIONAL USE - Public Hearings - October 13 & 20, 2014 – Linda Chen – Bed and Breakfast, 12514 Old Rt. 16.
