**ORDINANCE NO. 253**

**AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE SPEED LIMITS ON  
MONTEREY LANE NORTH T-700 AT 25 MPH.**

**WHEREAS**, Monterey Lane North between Route 16 and Charmian Rd. (T-701) is posted for 35 MPH and 40 MPH; and

**WHEREAS**, the Washington Township Board of Supervisors, in order to advance the welfare and safety of the residents of the Township and such other persons who use Monterey Lane North, deem it necessary to set a speed limit of 25 MPH on Monterey Lane North; and

**WHEREAS**, the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania, Section 6109 provides for the establishing of speed limits on roads; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 3362a (1.2) of the Vehicle Code provides for the establishment of a maximum speed of 25 MPH in any residential district; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors, retained the services of Grove Miller Engineering to complete a traffic study of Monterey Lane North; and

**WHEREAS**, the completed traffic study concluded that the speed limit on Monterey Lane North T-700 should be 25 MPH.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Washington, Franklin County, Pennsylvania pursuant to the authority as described above that Chapter 333, Article 1 of the Code of the Township of Washington, be amended as follows:

Section 1. Section 333-1, Speed limits established in the Code of the Township of Washington, shall be amended as follows:

<u>Road</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>	<u>Speed Limit</u>
1. Monterey Lane North T-700	PA Route 16	Charmian Rd. T-701	25 MPH

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be enforced in accordance with the provisions of the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania as it pertains to fines and other penalties.


Section 3. Should any provision of this Ordinance be found unconstitutional or otherwise illegal or in any other manner unenforceable, the remaining sections of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective as provided by law.
