

WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 5

An ordinance ordaining, laying out and opening certain roads in The Hess Addition to Wayne Heights, Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, to-wit: Oller Avenue, Landis Avenue, Strickler Avenue, Geiser Avenue and Clearview Terrace.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same;

SECTION I. That a certain road named Oller Avenue be and the same is hereby ordained, laid out, and opened on a course, the center line of which begins at a point at the southern most end of Oller Avenue, as presently ordained and laid out in Wayne Heights, Washington Township, and which point is the intersection of the northern most side of a 20 foot alley and Oller Avenue; thence South 20 degrees 01 minutes West 922 feet to a point on line of lands of Bessie and John Mikesell, said road having a width of 50 feet.

SECTION II. That a certain road named Landis Avenue be and the same is hereby ordained, laid out and opened on a course, the center line of which begins at a point at the southern most end of Landis Avenue, as presently ordained and laid out in Wayne Heights, Washington Township, and which point is at the intersection of the northern most line of a 20 foot alley and Landis Avenue; thence South 20 degrees 01 minutes West 624 feet to a point on the southerly side of Clearview Terrace, a point on line of lands of Daniel Hess, said road having a width of 50 feet.

SECTION III. That a certain road named Strickler Avenue be and the same is hereby ordained, laid out and opened on a course, the center line of which begins at the southern most end of Strickler Avenue as presently ordained and laid out in Wayne Heights, Washington Township and which point is the intersection of the northerly side of a 20 foot alley and Strickler Avenue; thence South 20 degrees 01 minutes West 619.1 feet to a point on the southerly side of Clearview Terrace along line of lands of Daniel Hess, said road having a width of 50 feet.

SECTION IV. That a certain road named Geiser Avenue be and the same is hereby ordained, laid out and opened on a course, the center line of which begins at the southern most end of Geiser Avenue, as presently ordained and laid out in Wayne Heights, Washington Township, and which point is the intersection of the northerly line of a 20 foot alley and Geiser Avenue; thence South 20 degrees 01 minutes West 660.5 feet to a point on the southerly side of Clearview Terrace along line of lands of Daniel Hess, said road having a width of 50 feet.

SECTION V. That a certain road named Clearview Terrace be and the same is hereby ordained, laid out and opened on a course, the center line of which begins at a point along line of lands of C. R. Pryor, and which point is South 16 degrees 15 minutes West 15 feet from the southeast corner of Lot #6 of Section X of the Hess Addition to Wayne Heights; thence North 69 degrees 59 minutes West 1616 feet to a point, the intersection of the easterly line of a 20 foot alley and Clearview Terrace, along line of lands of Daniel Hess.

SECTION VI. There is adopted as a part of this ordinance a plan and map of the foregoing roads showing the width and location thereof, as prepared by John H. McClellan, Registered Surveyor, February 22-25, 1954 and available for inspection at the Office of the Secretary, Melvin T. Sease, Rouzerville, Pennsylvania.

SECTION VII. Said roads shall hereafter be and become a part of the public road system of Washington Township.

Ordained and enacted into an ordinance this 5<sup>th</sup> day of Feb., 1955.
