ordinance no. $\underline{\mathcal{S}}$

An Ordiname ordaining, laying out and opening road in Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. That a certain road leading from the intersection of Pennsylvania Legislative Route No. 28024 and Washington Township Road No. 375 to Washington Township-Quincy Township boundary, be and the same is hereby ordained, laid out and opened on a course the centerline of which begins at the intersection of the centerline of Washington Township Road No. 375 and Pennsylvania Legislative Highway Route No. 28024; thence North 19 degrees 37 minutes West 632.8 feet to a point; thence North 20 degrees 58 minutes East 420.1 feet to a point on the Quincy Township-Washington Township boundary; said road having a total length of 1052.9 feet and being 33 feet in width, all of which shall be used as a roadway.

SECTION 2. There is adopted as a part of this Ordinance a plan and map of the foregoing road showing the location thereof as prepared by John H. McClellan, R. S., surveyed May 21, 1956.

SECTION 3. Said road shall hereafter be and become a part of the public road system of Washington Township.
