

Washington Township Ordinance No. 9

An Ordinance ordaining, laying out, and opening a certain road near Pennersville in Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, to-wit, Carrosmar Farm Road.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. That a certain road named Carrosmar Farm Road be and the same is hereby ordained, laid out and opened on a course, the center line of which begins at a point in the center of Washington Township Road No. 378, at a distance of 644 feet Northwardly from Washington Township Road No. 377; thence south 63° west 1289.8 feet to a point; thence south 61° 35 minutes west 48.8 feet to a point; thence on a curve to the right having a radius of 180 feet a distance of 178.6 feet to a point; thence north 65° 15 minutes west 71 feet to a point; thence south 65° west 49.6 feet to a point; thence south 46° 45 minutes west 208.5 feet to a point; thence on a turn-around clock-wise the following courses and distances: south 10° 30 minutes west 66 feet; south 35° 30 minutes west 49 feet; south 70° 45 minutes west 60 feet; north 52° 30 minutes west 104 feet; north 43° east 64 feet; north 75° 30 minutes east 65 feet; south 83° 30 minutes east 69 feet; said road having a total length of 2323.3 feet and being 33 feet in width, all of which shall be used as a roadway.

SECTION 2. There is adopted as a part of this Ordinance a plan and map of the foregoing road showing the location thereof as prepared by John H. Atherton, surveyed December 1, 1956 and June 7, 1957.

SECTION 3. Said road shall hereafter be and become a part of the public road system of Washington Township.

Ordained and enacted into an Ordinance this 2nd day of September, 1957.
