

ORDINANCE NO. # 12

An Ordinance Ordaining, Laying Out And
Opening a Certain Road in Washington
Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania,
to wit: Grandview Drive

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION 1. That a certain road named Grandview Drive be and the same is hereby ordained, laid out and opened on a course, the center line of which begins at a point on the Southerly side of Pennsylvania Highway Route No. 16, which point lies between lands of Mrs. Mary A. Bonebrake and land of Paul T. Boswell; thence South 16 degrees 15 minutes West 266 feet to an iron pin; thence North 85 degrees 17 minutes West 72 feet to an iron pin; thence North 73 degrees 45 minutes West 110 feet to an iron pin; thence South 17 degrees West 444.2 feet to an iron pin; thence South 40 degrees 15 minutes West 186.9 feet to an iron pin; thence South 44 degrees 3 minutes West 210.5 feet to an iron pin on the Northeasterly line of lands of Katherine Steiner, said road having a total length of 1289.6 feet and being 33 feet in width.

SECTION 2. There is adopted as part of this Ordinance a plan and map of the foregoing road showing the location thereof as prepared by John H. McClellan, Registered Surveyor, October 21, 1954, revised June 4, 1960.

SECTION 3. This road shall hereafter be and become a part of the public road system of Washington Township.

Ordained and enacted into an Ordinance this 2nd day of December, 1960.
