

ORDINANCE NO. 14

An Ordinance Ordaining, Laying Out and Opening a Certain Road in Blue Ridge Summit, Washington Township, to-wit: Norwood Avenue

Be it ordained and enacted by the Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

SECTION I. That a certain road named Norwood Avenue be and the same is hereby ordained, laid out, extended and opened on a course, the center line of which begins at a spike marking the intersection of the center line of Crawford Avenue with the center line of Norwood Avenue and being distant Eastwardly 776.5 feet from the center line of Pennsylvania Legislative Route No. 28027, known as Monterey Avenue; thence South 74 degrees 13 minutes East 533 feet to a point; thence on a curve to the left having a radius 85 feet a distance of 159.52 feet to a point; thence North 1 degree 45 minutes West 47.68 feet to a point; thence on a curve to the right having a radius of 92.78 feet a distance of 148.52 feet to a point; thence due East 384.66 feet to a point; thence on a curve to the left having a radius of 193.50 feet a distance of 288.75 feet to a point; thence North 4 degrees 30 minutes East 100.85 feet to the southernmost terminus of Norwood Avenue, extended, said road having a total length of 1662.71 feet and being 33 feet in width; and also an additional tract adjoining the Northwesterly side of the first above mentioned curve to the left beginning at a point on the Northerly limit of right of way opposite Station 4 / 85.3 and extending Eastwardly to a point opposite Station 5 / 33 and distant 10 feet at right angles from the Northerly limit of the aforesaid right of way; thence on a curve to the left having a radius of 58.5 feet a distance of 109.92 feet to a point opposite Station 7 / 65 and distant 10 feet at right angles from the Westerly limit of the aforesaid right of way; thence extending Northwardly to a point on the Westerly limit of right of way opposite Station 8 / 12.68 all of which shall be used as a roadway.

SECTION 2. There is adopted as a part of this Ordinance a plan and map of the foregoing road showing the location thereof as prepared by John H. McClellan, Registered Surveyor, July 15, 1960, revised November 1, 1960, and November 24, 1960.

SECTION 3. This road shall hereafter be and become a part of the public road system of Washington Township.

Ordained and enacted into an Ordinance this 22d day of March, 1961.
