

ORDINANCE NO. 18

An Ordinance laying out and opening a certain road at Blue Ridge Summit, Washington Township, Franklin County, to-wit: Pinola Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

Section 1. That a certain road to be known as Pinola Avenue be and the same is hereby ordained, laid out and opened on a course, the center line of which begins at a point in the center line of Pennsylvania Legislative Highway Route 28027 (35 feet wide) in the Village of Blue Ridge Summit, which point is midway between an extension of the property lines of Elred Bock on the South and Wilbur Raifsnider on the North; thence North 87 degrees 4 minutes West 370.2 feet to a point in the center line of Washington Township Road No. 398, known as Blue Ridge Avenue, said road having a total length of 370.2 feet and being 50 feet in width, all of which shall be used as a roadway.

Section 2. There is adopted as a part of this Ordinance a plan and map of the foregoing road showing the location thereof as prepared by John H. McClellan, Registered Surveyor, dated July 7, 1962.

Section 3. This road shall hereafter be and become a part of the public road system of Washington Township.
