ORDINANCE NO. 28

An Ordinance laying out and opening a certain road at Blue Ridge Summit, in Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, to wit: Dutrow Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

Section 1. That a certain road to be known as Dutrow Avenue be and the same is hereby ordained, laid out, and opened on a course, the center line of which begins at a point in Pennsylvania Legislative Highway Route 28027 opposite lands of Harry H. Youngs; thence North 82 degrees 58 minutes West 137.5 feet to a point marked by the extension of the division line between the properties of Nina S. Gaver and Harry H. Youngs; thence on a curve to the left having a radius of 1674.16 feet, a distance of 897.53 feet by lands of Nina S. Gaver, Laura G. Dutrow, John C. Harbaugh, formerly Robert E. Burns, Walter H. Duffield and the Western Maryland Railway Co.; thence South 66 degrees 19 minutes West 163.97 feet to Station No. 11 99; thence by lands of Flohr Lumber Company and Isaac L. Ramsburg South 63 degrees 36 minutes West 226.8 feet to Station 14 25.8 on the Pennsylvania-Maryland State Line, said road having a total length of 1425.8 feet measured on the center line and being 33 feet in width, all of which shall be used as a roadway.

Section 2. There is adopted as a part of this Ordinance a plan and map of the foregoing road showing the location thereof as prepared by John H. McClellan, Registered Surveyor, dated January 24, 1967.

Section 3. The aforesaid road shall hereafter be and become a part of the public road system of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania.

Ordained and enacted into an Ordinance this 1st day of April, 1968.
