ORDINANCE NO. 50

An Ordinance of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Washington, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, amending and supplementing Ordinance No. 39, establishing the rules and regulations for conduct and use of Red Run Park.

WHEREAS, on the 15th day of May, 1972, the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township adopted in lawful session duly assembled, Ordinance No. 39, establishing rules and regulations for conduct of use of Red Run Park and such other parks as the Board of Supervisors may from time to time acquire; and

WHEREAS, Section 3 of said Ordinance No. 39 sets forth certain prohibited acts in said Red Run Park and such other parks as the Board of Supervisors may in the future acquire from time to time, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors deem it in the best interest and general welfare of the residents of the Township and such other persons who use said Red Run Park to prohibit swimming in Red Run Lake situate in said Red Run Park.

NOW THEREFORE be it enacted and ordained and it is enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township that Section 3 of Ordinance No. 39 be amended and supplemented as follows:


Section 1: Swimming in Red Run Lake situate in Red Run Park shall be prohibited at all times. The penalty for violation of this section shall be as provided for in Section 5 of Ordinance No. 39.

Secton 2: All existing provisions of Ordinance No. 39 shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall become effective July 12, 1975.




