ORDINANCE NO. 71

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS TOWNSHIP,
AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING ORDINANCE NO. 39, REGULATING THE
USE OF RED RUN PARK, BY PROVIDING FOR RESTRICTIONS ON
PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN SAID RED RUN PARK.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, on May 15, 1972, enacted Ordinance No. 39, establishing rules and regulations for the conduct and use of Red Run Park; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors deem it necessary, for the continued enjoyment of the use of said park to regulate and restrict the parking of motor vehicles within said park.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is enacted and ordained, by the Board of Supervisors of this Township, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Ordinance no. 39 is amended to provide as follows:

SECTION 2.: The "Red Run Park" and such other parks as are hereafter acquired by the Township of Washington, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, shall be closed from 9 o'clock P.M. prevailing time, until sunrise. All persons found within the park or any parks of the Twonship of Washington, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, between the hours shall be subject to the penalties herein provided by this Ordinance unless they have secured written permission form the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Washington, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, to be in and use said park during the time that the park is closed; provided, however, that the provisions of this section shall not apply to persons actively fishing in Red Run Lake.

SECTION 2: Section 3 of Ordinance no. 39 is amended and supplemented to add the following subdivision:

- T. (1) No motor vehicle shall be parked within said Red Run Park from 9 o'clock, P.M. prevailing time, until sunrise, except within areas specifically reserved for parking by the Board of Supervisors as marked by identification signs for such purpose.
- (2) No truck or truck tractor classified as a class 6 or higher truck or truck tractor according to the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, or trailer drawn by a truck tractor, shall be parked anywhere within Red Run Park from sunrise, Saturday, until sunrise, Monday, or from sunrise until 9 o'clock, P.M., prevailing time on legally designated holidays between April 1 and November 1.
- (3) The terms "motor vehicle", "truck", "truck tractor" and "trailer" shall have the same meaning as those terms have in the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code.


SECTION 3. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be enforceable in accordance with the provisions of Section 5 of Ordinance No. 39.

SECTION 4. All other provisions of said Ordinance No. 39 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days from the enactment hereof.


