ORDINANCE NO. 78

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS TOWNSHIP AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING ORDINANCE NO. 39, REGULATING THE USE OF RED RUN PARK, BY PROVIDING FOR RESTRICTIONS ON PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN SAID RED RUN PARK.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, on May 15, 1972, enacted Ordinance nO. 39, establishing rules and regulations for the conduct and use of Red Run Park; and

WHEREAS, on June 15, 1981, the Board of Supervisors enacted Ordinance No. 71, amending said Ordinance No. 39 by providing regulations as to the parking of motor vehicles within said park.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors deem it necessary, for the continued enjoyment of the use of said park to prohibit the parking of trucks and truck tractors within said park.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is enacted and ordained, by the Borad of Supervisors of this Township, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 3 of Ordinance No. 39 as amended by Section 2 of Ordinance No. 71, is amended as follows:

- T. (2) No truck or truck tractor classified as a class 6 or higher truck or truck tractor according to the Pennsulvania Vehicle Code, or trailer drawn by a truck tractor, shall be parked anywhere within Red Run Park at any time.

SECTION 2. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be enforceable in accordance with the provisions of Section 5 of the Ordinance No. 39.

SECTION 3. All other provisions of said Ordinance No. 39 and all its amendments shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days from enactment hereof.
