

ORDINANCE NO. 91

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WASHINGTON
TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA
LAYING OUT AND ORDAINING NORTH LANDIS AVENUE

WHEREAS, the Second Class Township Code, Act of May 1, 1983, P.L. 103, Article XI, Section 1101, as amended, 53 P.S. 66101 authorizes the Board of Supervisors to enact, ordain, survey, layout, open, widen, straighten, vacate and relay all roads and parts thereof which are wholly within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of this Township deem it advantageous and necessary to lay out and ordain North Landis Avenue situate in Washington Township.

NOW THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained, and it is enacted and ordained, by the Board of Supervisors of this Township as follows:

Section 1: The following street is hereby laid out and ordained, and shall be known as North Landis Avenue: Beginning at a set iron pin on the North side of Pennsylvania Route 16, known as East Main Street, at lands of Millard A. Ullman and Thomas M. Painter; thence, with same North 23 degrees 30 minutes 19 seconds East 445.94 feet to a set iron pin at lands of Waynesboro Construction Co.; thence, with same South 65 degrees 38 minutes 29 seconds East 50.00 feet to a set iron pin at lands of Waynesboro Day Care Center; thence, with same South 23 degrees 30 minutes 19 seconds West 445.98 feet to a set iron pin on the North side of East Main Street; thence, with same 65 degrees 35 minutes 38 seconds West 50.00 feet to a set iron pin, the place of beginning. CONTAINING 22,295 square feet, or 0.51 acres, according to a draft and survey prepared by R. Lee Royer, R.S., intended to be recorded among the land records of Franklin County, Pennsylvania.


Section 2: Said street shall hereafter be and become a part of the public road system of Washington Township.

Section 3: Effective date: This ordinance shall become effective five days after the adoption hereof.
