ORDINANCE NO. 113

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS ON CERTAIN STREETS AND ROADS WITHIN WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, there are certain streets and roads within Washington Township upon which no speed limits have been established; and

WHEREAS, the Washington Township Board of Supervisors, in order to advance the welfare and safety of the residents of the Township and such other persons who use said streets and roads, deems it necessary to enact speed limitations on certain streets and roads in Washington Township; and

WHEREAS, the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania, Section 6109, provides for the establishing of speed limits on streets and roads; and

WHEREAS, Section 3362 of the Vehicle Code provides for the establishment of a maximum speed of 35 mph in any urban district; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, after completing studies of the following streets and roads, finds them to be either within an "urban district" as per the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania or otherwise in need of speed limitations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is enacted and ordained, by the Board of Supervisors of this Township, as follows:

Section 1. The maximum speed limit for the following streets and roads is hereby established as follows:

	STREET OR ROAD	BETWEEN	SPEED LIMIT (mph)
1.	Summit Farms Drive T309	Monterey Lane SR2011 and Jacobs Church Rd. T377	25
2.`	Bailey Springs Road T350	Mentzer Gap Rd. T378 and the end of T350	25
3.	Brookdale Dr. T685	Old Forge Rd. T392 and the end of T685	25
4.	Village Heights Dr. T319	PA Rt 16 SR0016 and the end of T319	25

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be enforced in accordance with the provisions of the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania as it pertains to fines and other penalties.

Section 3. Should any provision of this Ordinance be found unconstitutional or otherwise illegal or in any other manner unenforceable, the remaining sections of the Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after enactment thereof.
