

**ORDINANCE NO. 119**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, RENEWING THE AGRICULTURAL SECURITY AREA WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP, FIRST ESTABLISHED IN 1983, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THE AGRICULTURAL AREA SECURITY LAW, ACT OF JUNE 30, 1981, P.L. 128, NO. 43, AS AMENDED.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of this Township on December 5, 1983, by adopting Ordinance # 85, created the first Agricultural Security Area within Washington Township; and

**WHEREAS**, the Agricultural Area Security Law requires Washington Township Supervisors to review the established Agricultural Security Area each seven years; and

**WHEREAS**, 1990 is seven years from the adoption of Ordinance # 85; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors of this Township has reviewed a proposal for the renewal of the existing agricultural security area within the Township, and has received proposed modifications to said proposal; and

**WHEREAS**, said proposal and modifications thereto have been reviewed by the Township Planning Commission and the Township Agricultural Security Area Advisory Committee, and the Board of Supervisors has received the recommendations of the Planning Commission and the Committee; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors conducted a public hearing on said proposal and modifications on July 16, 1990; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors believes it is in the best interests and general welfare of the residents of the Township to renew the agricultural area within the Township.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AN ORDAINED**, and it is enacted and ordained, by the Board of Supervisors of this Township, in accordance with the provisions of the Agricultural Area Security Law, the Act of June 30, 1981, P.L. 128, No. 43 as amended, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** There is hereby established in Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, a revised Agricultural Security Area comprising those lands shown on the map attached hereto and made a part of this Ordinance, which shall hereafter be referred to as the Washington Township Agricultural Security Area Map.

The first part of the document discusses the importance of maintaining accurate records of all transactions. It emphasizes that every entry should be supported by a valid receipt or invoice. This ensures transparency and allows for easy verification of the data.

**SECTION 2.** From the effective date of this Ordinance, those lands comprising said agricultural security area shall be subject to the provisions of the Agricultural Area Security Law of June 30, 1981, P.L. 128, No. 43 as amended.

**SECTION 3.** Ordinance # 85, adopted December 5, 1983, is repealed in its entirety.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after its adoption.

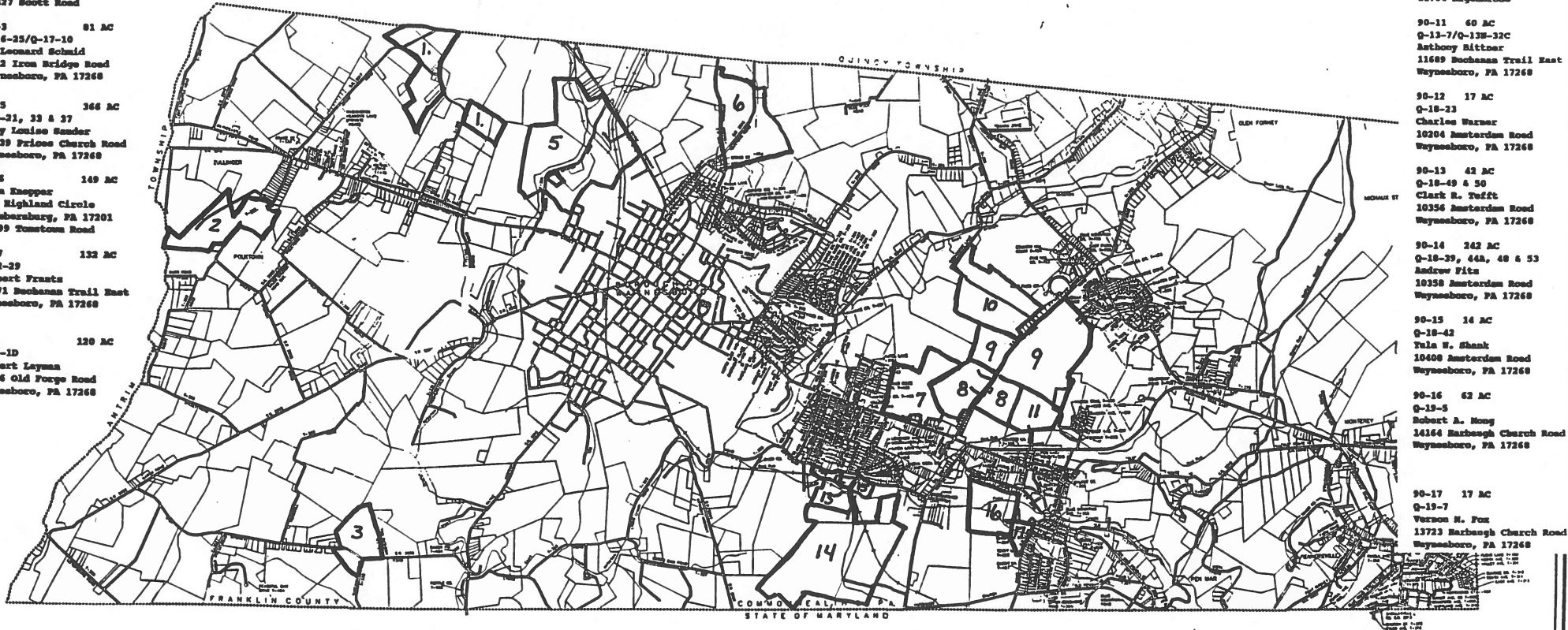
