ORDINANCE NUMBER: 154

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO 151, THE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP NON-UNIFORMED EMPLOYEE'S PLAN & TRUST BY DELETING THE REQUIREMENT THAT ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEES COMPLETE SIX (6) MONTHS OF FULL-TIME EMPLOYMENT BEFORE BECOMING ELIGIBLE FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE PENSION PLAN.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, on October 1, 1990, adopted Washington Township Ordinance Number 116, known as the Washington Township Non-Uniformed Employees Pension Plan and Trust as amended and restated the Plan and Trust on December 4, 2000, under Ordinance Number 151, and;

WHEREAS, it is the desire and intent of the Board of Supervisors to clarify eligibility conditions for participation in the Pension Plan and Trust.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of this Township as follows:

SECTION 1. Article I – Definition

1.15 “Employee” changed to “an active, full-time non-uniformed employee of the municipality employed for any six (6) consecutive months during the calendar year, working not less than 35 hours per week.”

1.17 “Entry Date” change to “immediate upon meeting the requirements of an Employee.”

SECTION 2. Article III – Eligibility

Section 3.1 This sentence shall replace the first sentence in this article “An Employee who was a Participant in the Plan prior to the Effective Date of this Amendment shall be eligible to participate in the Plan, thereafter any active, full-time non-uniformed employee of the municipality employed for any six (6) consecutive months during the calendar year, working not less than 35 hours per week.”


SECTION 3. In all other respects the provisions of Ordinance 151 shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after adoption.


