ORDINANCE NO. 156

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON,
FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, APPOINTING THE
ELECTED TAX COLLECTOR OF WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP
AS THE DELINQUENT TAX COLLECTOR**

WHEREAS, Section 26.1 of Act 104 of 2000 requires the governing bodies of townships to appoint the Elected tax Collector as a Delinquent Tax Collector (72 Ps §5511.26a); and

WHEREAS, Section 26.1 of Act 104 of 2000 also requires townships to provide for collection of delinquent taxes in accordance with Section 686 of the Act of March 10, 1949 (P.L. 30 No. 14), known as the "Public School Code of 1949" (72 Ps. §5511.26a); and

WHEREAS, the Township of Washington desires to comply with Section 26.1 of Act 104 of 2000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Washington, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, pursuant to the authority as described above and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows;

Section 1. Appointment of elected tax collector as delinquent tax collector.

The Elected Tax Collector of the Township of Washington is hereby appointed as the Delinquent Tax Collector.

Section 2. Powers, rights, privileges, duties and obligations of the delinquent tax collector.

The elected tax collector appointed as the delinquent tax collector shall have the same powers, rights, privileges, duties and obligations as set forth in 24 P.S. §6-686 of the Public School code of 1949. The collector of delinquent taxes shall also have all the authority and power now vested by law in the collector of non-delinquent Township taxes for the collection of such delinquent taxes.

Section 3. Term of appointment.

This appointment and authorization shall remain in effect until the Board of Supervisors, by ordinance, takes further action, as required by law.

Section 4. Vacancy.

In the event of a vacancy in the office of tax collector during the term of this appointment, the successor tax collector shall automatically succeed to the powers and duties set forth herein.

Section 5. Bond

The collector of delinquent taxes shall not be required to give additional bond on account of this appointment.

Section 6. Accounting

The collector of delinquent taxes shall account to the Board of Supervisors for all delinquent tax collections made, in the same manner as required for the reporting of non-delinquent tax collections.

Section 7. Compensation.

The collector of delinquent taxes shall be compensated in the same manner as provided for the collection of non-delinquent taxes within the township.

Section 8. Severability.

If any article, section, or provision of this Ordinance should be decided by the Court to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional or invalid.

Section 9. Repealer.


All other Township ordinances, or parts of other ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall be retroactive to December 31, 2001.


