ORDINANCE NO. 157

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON,
FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR
THE COMPENSATION OF THE MEMBERS OF THE
WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMISSION**

WHEREAS, the Washington Township Planning Commission was created by the Board of Supervisors in year 1967 with the adoption of Ordinance No. 26; and

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Ordinance No. 26 states that members of the Planning Commission, "shall serve without compensation...."; and

WHEREAS, in year 1968 after the adoption of Ordinance No. 26, the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, Act 247 of 1968 was enacted; and

WHEREAS, Section 202 of Act stated that, "all members of the commission shall serve without compensation...."; and

WHEREAS, Act 2 of 2002 amends Section 202 of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code to provide for compensation to the members of the Township Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Supervisors to provide compensation to the members of the Washington Township Planning Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Washington, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, pursuant to the authority as described above, and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

Section 1. Planning Commission compensation.

The compensation of the members of the Washington Township Planning Commission shall be established by resolution of the Board of Supervisors.

Section 2. Maximum compensation.

The members of the Washington Township Planning Commission shall be compensated at a rate not to exceed the compensation paid to the members of the Board of Supervisors.

Section 3. Reimbursement of expenses.

The members of the Washington Township Planning Commission may be reimbursed for necessary and reasonable expenses.

Section 4. Severability.

If any section or provision of this Ordinance should be decided by the Court to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional or invalid.

Section 5. Repealer.


Any provision of Ordinance 26 inconsistent with this Ordinance is repealed. All other provisions of Ordinance 26 shall remain in full force and effect except where they may conflict with Act 247 of 1968 as amended, the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code.

Section 6. Effective date.

This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after enactment thereof.



WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Supervisors to fix the salaries for members of the Washington Township Planning Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of this Township, that members of the Washington Township Planning Commission shall be paid the sum of twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars for their attendance at all future regularly scheduled and advertised special meetings of the commission, effective immediately.
