ORDINANCE NO. 188

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON,
FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING
ORDINANCES NOS. 151 AND 154, THE NON-UNIFORMED
EMPLOYEES PLAN AND TRUST TO CLARIFY THE DEFINITION
OF EMPLOYEE UNDER THE PENSION PLAN**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, on October 1, 1990, adopted Washington Township Ordinance Number 116, known as the Washington Township Non-Uniformed Employees Pension Plan and Trust as amended and restated the Plan and Trust on December 4, 2000, under Ordinance Number 151 and further amended the Plan and Trust on November 5, 2001, under Ordinance Number 154.

WHEREAS, it is the desire and intent of the Board of Supervisors to clarify eligibility conditions for participation in the Pension Plan and Trust.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of this Township as follows:

SECTION 1. Article I--Definitions, is hereby amended to delete existing Section 1.15 in its entirety and replace it with the following:

1.15 "Employee" shall mean an active non-uniformed employee of the municipality that is classified as a full-time employee by the municipality and who is employed for any six (6) consecutive months during the calendar year, working not less than 35 hours per week.


SECTION 2. In all other respects Ordinance Nos. 151 and 154 shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after adoption.
