Support of Marsy's Law


WHEREAS, Marsy's law is a constitutional amendment supporting greater rights for victims of crime which passed unanimously through the 2018 Pennsylvania Legislature and will be considered one more time in the 2019 Legislative Year before being sent to the voters of Pennsylvania for final approval; and

WHEREAS, Governor Tom Wolfe, the Pennsylvania Chiefs of Police Association, Pennsylvania District Attorneys Association and the Lackawanna County District Attorney are in support of Marsy's Law.
