**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS  
TOWNSHIP ESTABLISHING THE MATTERS TO BE REFERRED  
TO THE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP PLANNING COMMITTEE**

**WHEREAS**, Washington Township has established a Planning Committee as an advisory planning agency under the Municipal Planning Code; and

**WHEREAS**, the only mandatory duties required to be performed by a township planning agency under § 209.1 of the Municipalities Planning Code and § 62-3 of the Code of Washington Township are the preparation of the comprehensive plan of development and the maintenance of records of its actions, with all other duties of the planning agency occurring solely at the request of the governing body, and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Supervisors desires to establish guidelines as to what matters the Township Planning Committee's input is requested.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors that the following matters will be referred to the Planning Committee:

1. Any appropriate matter so requested in writing by the applicant
2. Any appropriate matter requested by the Township Zoning Officer
3. Any subdivision involving four or more lots
4. Any other appropriate matter expressly referred to the Planning Committee by the Board of Supervisors
