RESOLUTION NO. 771

A RESOLUTION OF THE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING TO THE COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA FOR THE REDEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE CAPITAL PROGRAM ("RACP") IN THE AMOUNT OF TWO-MILLION DOLLARS (\$2,000,000) FOR THE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP MUNICIPAL COMPLEX PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Office of the Budget notified Washington Township, that the Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has authorized the release of Two Million (\$2,000,000) in RACP funds (the "Grant") for the Washington Township Municipal Complex Project (the "Project") located in Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, and has requested that Washington Township prepare and submit a formal and complete RACP application to the Office of the Budget; and

WHEREAS, the Project is integral to improve workflow and efficiency for the Township; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY BCDA BOARD OF DIRECTORS as follows:

1. Washington Township supports the RACP Grant in the amount of \$2,000,000 to be used for the construction of 12,121 Square foot office building and 3,589 square foot detached pole barn/car port building in Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania; and
2. Project costs include general building, plumbing, mechanical, and electrical construction of a 12,121 square foot office building that will house the Township's administrative offices, the supervisors' meeting room, the tax collector, and the police station; and
3. Washington Township agrees to serve as the Grantee for the Grant; and
4. Washington Township authorizes Jeffrey Geesaman, Township Manager, and/or Vernon Ashway, Assistant Township Manager, to execute all documents and agreements between Washington Township and the Pennsylvania Office of the Budget to facilitate and assist in obtaining the requested grant.
