A RESOLUTION OF THE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING AND DESIGNATING OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE ASSOCIATED GRANT DOCUMENTS.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania (the "Township") desires to advance the Route 16 Traffic Signal Synchronization Project ("Project") to re-time five (5) signals located along Buchanan Trail East in the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Project is intended to reduce traffic congestion, reduce carbon emissions, improve mobility, enhance emergency services responses, further commercial activity, and promote the health, safety, and welfare of the residents; and

WHEREAS, the Township has been awarded a Green-Light-Go, a grant program administered by the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation ("PennDOT"), in the amount of \$78,500; and

WHEREAS, the Township has determined that implementing the Project will benefit the community.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Washington Township Board of Supervisors, as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. The Township hereby designates Vernon L. Ashway, Jr., Assistant Township Manager (vla@washtwp-franklin.org), as the official authorized to execute all documents and agreements between the Township and PennDOT to facilitate and assist in executing the awarded Green-Light-Go grant.
- 3. The provisions of this resolution shall be severable, and if any of its provisions shall be held unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality, or invalidity shall not affect the validity of any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.
- 4. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
- 5. All other resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
