RESOLUTION # 776

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS
TOWNSHIP REGARDING TAX COLLECTORS AS REQUIRED BY ACT 57 OF 2022**

WHEREAS, Washington Township is a taxing district under the Local Tax Collection Law;
and

WHEREAS, Act 57 of 2022 amends the Local Tax Collection Law to require taxing districts to pass an ordinance or resolution requiring a tax collector to waive additional charges on real estate taxes under certain circumstances,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors as follows:

In accordance with Act 57 of 2022 and the Local Tax Collection Law, any and all tax collectors, as defined under the Local Tax Collection Law, for Washington Township shall waive additional charges for real estate taxes, beginning in the 2023 tax year, if the taxpayer does all of the following:

- (i) Provides a waiver request of additional charges to the tax collector in possession of the claim within twelve months of a qualifying event;
- (ii) Attests that a notice was not received;
- (iii) Provides the tax collector in possession of the claim with one of the following:
 - (A) A copy of the deed showing the date of real property transfer; or
 - (B) A copy of the title following the acquisition of a mobile or manufactured home subject to taxation as real estate showing the date of issuance or a copy of an executed lease agreement between the owner of a mobile or manufactured home and the owner of a parcel of land on which the mobile or manufactured home will be situated showing the date the lease commences; and
- (iv) Pays the face value amount of the tax notice for the real estate tax with the waiver request.
