RESOLUTION # 130

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS TOWNSHIP AMENDING SECTION 302.5, AREA RESIDENCY, OF RESOLUTION # 83, POLICE DEPARTMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, Resolution # 83, Police Department Rules and Regulations were adopted by the Township Board of Supervisors on November 15, 1982; and

WHEREAS, Section 302.5, area residency requires each new applicant of the Police Department to become a resident of Washington Township within 1 year after appointment; and

WHEREAS, the Washington Township Board of Supervisors desire to amend Section 302.5.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township that Section 302.5 of Resolution # 83 is amended as follows:

Section 1, Section 302.5 of Resolution # 83 shall be amended as per the following — Area residency: Each applicant who is not a resident of Washington Township must consent in writing to become a resident of Washington Township, the Boro of Waynesboro, or the Township of Quincy within a radius of six (6) miles of the Township police station.

Section 2. This amendment shall take effect immediately.
