RESOLUTION # 133

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS TOWNSHIP ALLOCATING THE VOLUNTEER FIREMAN RELIEF ASSOCIATION FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE COMMONWEALTH AS PER ACT 205 TO THE VARIOUS ELIGIBLE RELIEF ASSOCIATIONS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, Act 205, The Municipal Pension Plan Funding Standards and Recovery Act of 1984 provides for an annual contribution from the Commonwealth to the Township for distribution to eligible relief associations;

WHEREAS, the Act requires that the Board of Supervisors by resolution, determine the amount of the contribution that shall be distributed to each eligible relief association; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors by Resolution # 132, established the Washington Township Volunteer Ambulance and Rescue Squad Relief Association on October 5, 1987; and

WHEREAS, the Washington Township Volunteer Ambulance and Rescue Squad Relief Association was established as a second relief association within the Township and is eligible to receive Act 205 Relief Association funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors, that the distribution of the Commonwealth's allocation for the benefit of the relief associations shall be divided annually between the two relief associations based on the following percentage:

Washington Township Volunteer Fireman Relief Association 75% Washington Township Volunteer Ambulance and Rescue Squad Relief Association 25%.
