RESOLUTION NO. 137

BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF WASHIGNTON TOWNSHIP,
FRANKLIN COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ELIMINATING MEMBER
CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE POLICE PENSION FUND, IN
ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 7 (a) OF ORDINANCE NO. 64,
FOR THE YEARS 1987 AND 1988.

WHEREAS, Section 7 (A) of Ordinance No. 64, known as the
Police Pension Fund Ordinance, provides for the elimination of
member contributions to the Police Pension Fund on an annual
basis, if an actuarial study shows that the condition of the
police pension fund is such that payments into the fund by
members may be eliminated, and that if such payments are
eliminated, contributions by the Township will not be required to
keep the fund actuarially sound; and


WHEREAS, the Township has received such an actuarial study
indicating elimination of member contributions for the plan years
1987 and 1988 will not affect the actuarial soundness of the
fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, be in resolved, and it is hereby resolved,
by the Board of Supervisors of the Township, that , in accordance
with the provisions of Section 7 (A) of Ordinance No. 64 and the
actuarial report received by the Township, member contributions
to the Police Pension Fund for the Police Pension Fund for the
fund years 1987 and 1988 are hereby eliminated.
