

Resolution Adopting Comprehensive Plan #6

WHEREAS, pursuant to the powers authorized by the Second Class Township Code and the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, the Washington Township Planning and Zoning Commission proposed a Comprehensive Plan for the further development of the Township of Washington, and

WHEREAS, the Washington Township Planning and Zoning Commission recommended that the said Comprehensive Plan be adopted by the Township of Washington, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to public notice, a public hearing was held by the Township of Washington on July 1, 1970, at which time the proposed Comprehensive Plan, together with all maps, charts, textual matter, and other matters intended to form the Plan were reviewed, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Washington, Franklin County, at its regular meeting on July 6, 1970, again reviewed the proposed Comprehensive Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Washington, Franklin County, do hereby adopt the Comprehensive Plan together with the maps, charts, textual matter and other matters therein contained and intended to form the Plan.
