I hereby certify that the following is a copy of the Resolution adopted by the Washington Township Board of Supervisors of the regular meeting held August 2, 1971.

Be it resolved that in as much as the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin Co., Penna. a body vested by the electorate to administer the public affairs of said township adopt as its policy from this day forward not to enter upon private property for the purpose of constructing or repairs of drains, culverts, roadways or driveways, nor to plow snow or erect snow fence on same, except as legally empowered in cases of emergency or in cases of furthering the general public welfare and only where the proper rights-of-way and easements have been obtained and the supervisors have assurance that their employees and equipment are properly insured both for damage and liability.
