

RESOLUTION

Designating an agent to act for and on behalf of the Township of Washington, Franklin County, Pennsylvania in obtaining Federal assistance for flood damage.

WHEREAS, certain streets and roads and other public property within the boundaries of the Township of Washington, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, suffered damage during June, 1972, as a result of flood waters caused by tropical storm Agnes;

AND WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors for Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, deem it adviseable to make application for Federal assistance to allay the costs incurred in repairing said damage;

AND WHEREAS, in order to obtain prompt Federal assistance, it is necessary that the Board of Supervisors designate an agent to act for and on behalf of the Township of Washington in obtaining said Federal assistance;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Washington, Franklin County, Pennsylvania hereby designates Andrew S. Fitz, Secretary of said Board, as its agent to act for and on behalf of the Township of Washington, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, in the performance of all duties incidental to obtaining prompt Federal assistance for the repair of damage resulting from tropical storm Agnes.
