

THIS RESOLUTION

By the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, indicating the desire of said Township participate in the Pavement Marking Demonstration Program under Section 205 of the Federal Aid Highway Act of 1973.

WHEREAS, under Section 205 of the Federal Aid Highway Act of 1973, the United States Congress established a Pavement Marking Demonstration Program to enable the several States to improve the marking of highways to provide for greater vehicle and pedestrian safety; and

WHEREAS, under said Act, Federal Monies have been allocated to implement said Program, with priority in application of said funds to be given to projects which are located in rural areas and which are either on the Federal Aid Secondary System, or are not included on any Federal Aid System; and

WHEREAS, the entire cost of said Projects shall be paid from Federal monies authorized to carry out the program, with no cost to the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, deem it in the best interests of the Township to participate in the said Program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township shall do and perform all acts necessary to participate in the Pavement Marking Demonstration Program under Section 205 of the Federal Aid Highway Act of 1973, including, but not limited to, identifying and painting roads which are eligible for marking under said Program.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township shall file a certified copy of the within Resolution with the District Engineer, Department of Transportation, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
