

## THIS RESOLUTION

By the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, revising the Washington Township Official Act 537 Sewage Disposal Plan to provide for the use of holding tanks in certain instances.

WHEREAS, the Township of Washington, by Ordinance No. 45, enacted and ordained on October 20, 1973, provided for the use of holding tanks in lieu of treatment tanks and subsurface absorption areas under the provisions of the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535 (35 P.S. Sec, 750.1 et. seq.), as amended, and Rules and Regulations adopted by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources pursuant thereto; and

WHEREAS, said Rules and Regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources pursuant thereto; and

WHEREAS, said Rules and Regulations of the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources require that the Township revise its official Act 537 Sewage Disposal Plan to reflect the use of holding tanks in the Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, that the Official Act 537 Sewage Disposal Plan of the said Washington Township is hereby revised to provide that holding tanks may be used in Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, in lieu of treatment tanks and subsurface absorption areas only on lots in areas planned to be sewerred in three to five years according to Alternate 9 of the Washington Township Official Act 537 Plan and which lots do not qualify for subsurface sewage disposal.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that holding tanks shall be utilized in said Washington Township only in accordance with the provisions of Washington Township Ordinance No. 45 and the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act, as amended, and Rules and Regulations adopted by the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources pursuant thereto.
