

THIS RESOLUTION

By the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, accepting for dedication certain lands offered for use as roadways in the Township.

WHEREAS, certain lands in Washington Township have been offered for dedication by deed to the Township to be used as roadways in said Township; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township to accept in the name of said Washington Township said lands so offered for dedication.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the following lands offered for dedication by deed are hereby accepted as roadways and shall hereafter be and become a part of the public road system of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania.

1. Buena Vista and Monta Vista Drive, lying and being situate in Long Meadow Estate Development, as more fully described in Deed of Dedication dated October 2, 1974 from Monta Vista Realty Company, together with a plan and map of said road as prepared by John H. McClellan, Registered Surveyor, dated July 15, 1959, as revised January 15, 1960 and November 9, 1960, said Deed of Dedication and accompanying plan and map being attached hereto, made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "A".

2. Orchard Lane together with the cul-de-sacs thereto known as Orchard Court and Orchard Circle, lying and being situate in the Antietam East Development, as more fully described in Deed of Dedication dated September 30, 1974 from Ernest F. Hess, together with a plan and map of said road as prepared by William A. Brindle Associates, dated September 24, 1971 revised April 10, 1972, and recorded in Franklin County Deed Book Volume 288A, Page 212 (Part 2), said Deed of Dedication

and accompanying plan and map being attached hereto, made a part hereof, and marked Exhibit "B".

3. Gardner Avenue, lying and being situate in Mar-Pen Estates Development as more particularly described in Deed of Dedication dated September 27, 1974 from Mar-Pen, Inc., together with a plan and map of said road as prepared by John H. McClellan, Registered Surveyor, dated July 29, 1964, and recorded among the Franklin County land records, said Deed of Dedication and accompanying map and plan being attached hereto, made a part hereof and marked Exhibit C.

4. Bayer Drive, together with certain segments of land at the intersection of Bayer Drive and Pennsylvania Legislative Route 28025 lying and being situate in Mountain View Sub-Division, as more fully described in Deed of Dedication dated October 4, 1974 from Harlan J. Bayer and Betty L. Bayer, his wife, together with a plan and map of said road as prepared by William A. Brindle Associates, dated November 17, 1971, said Deed of Dedication and accompanying plan and map being attached hereto, made part hereof and marked Exhibit D.
