

THIS RESOLUTION

By the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, accepting for dedication certain lands offered for use as a walkway in the Township.

WHEREAS, the First National Bank and Trust Company, Waynesboro, Pennsylvania, as Executor of the Estate of Edna M. Minick, late of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, deceased, has, by Deed of Dedication dated December 9, 1974, offered for dedication to the Township, certain lands to be used as a walkway only, and never to be used as a street or driveway; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township to accept in the name of said Washington Township said lands so offered for dedication.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved, that the following lands offered for dedication by deed are hereby accepted by Washington Township to be used as a walkway only and never as a street or driveway:

ALL that real estate lying and being situate in Washington Township near the eastern limits of the Borough of Waynesboro, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, bounded and described as follows;

BEGINNING at a point on the north curb line of Mountain View Road, said point being north 48 degrees west 37.5 feet from the southwest corner of Lot No. 18 of Section H; thence north 48 degrees west 30.5 feet along the northerly curb line of Mountain View Road to a point; thence north 42 degrees east 158 feet to a point; thence south 48 degrees east 30.5 feet along the north boundary line of Eastland Hills to a point; thence south 42 degrees west 158 feet to the place of beginning.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is adopted as part of this resolution a plan and map of the foregoing walkway as prepared by Arrowood, Inc., surveyed November 1, 1972.
