THIS RESOLUTION # 50

By the Board of Supervisors of Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, accepting for dedication certain lands offered for use as a roadway in the Township.

WHEREAS, a certain final plat for a portion of the Hollinger Estates Development has been heretofore approved by the Township pursuant to and under the provisions of Ordinance No. 56, known as the Washington Township Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, said approved final plat is recorded in Franklin County Plat Book Volume 288B, Page 569, and

WHEREAS, the owners and developers of said subdivision have offered to the Township for dedication as a public way a certain street shown therein as Kipe Drive, and to the extent that said street has been completed in accordance with the provisions of said Ordinance No. 56, the Township, pursuant to said Ordinance and pursuant to the provisions of the Second Class Township Code, desires to formally record its acceptance of said street for public road purposes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Kipe Drive containing 613.91 lineal feet in that portion of the Hollinger Sstates Development which the Township of Washington has heretofore given final approval is hereby accepted as a street for public road purposes in the Township of Washington, all requirements with respect to the construction therof as set forth in Ordinance No. 56, having been met.



RESOLVED this 7th. day of April, 1980, in lawful session duly assembled.


