- 4. Eastland Hills Traffic update. Mr. Christopher advised the Supervisors have talked with Dennis Miller, a traffic engineer, regarding the problem with traffic in Eastland Hills and possible Mr. Joe Doyle and Mr. Stanley Sargent, residents of the area, commented on their concerns for this area.

- FORMAC Report: Mr. Christopher advised he attended a meeting of FORMAC, a group working to keep Fort Ritchie open. - Train Station Materials Bids. We received telephone quotes from Cavetown Planning Mill, Lumber Yard, and Lowe's of Chambersburg for the materials to build the train station at the Red Run Park.
