Detailed Narrative Description of your Drug Reduction Program to include the complete scope, number of dedicated employees, area in square miles served and population of that area: The Washington Township Police Departments drug reduction program centers around three specific areas, Education, Enforcement and prevention. The supply of drugs in the area is wide spread from local dealers to major supplies moving in and out of the area. Any equipment available that would be useful in any of the above categories would be put to use to combat the problem. The impact of the equipment would allow movement in area that could not other wise be targeted due to lack of these resources. At the present time the department has seventeen sworn officers with several devoting a great deal of the time to drug investigation. Almost all of the sworn officers are members of the Franklin County Drug Task Force. The department has and makes





3. Resolution # 225, participation in the Pennsylvania Drug Reduction Property Program. On a Dick/Diller motion, the Supervisors authorized the Vice-Chairman to sign Resolution # 225, The DRPP will allow the Township to expand the realm of property available for the Township's drug reduction activity and the degree of service provided at the least possible cost. Vote was 3 - 0.

4. Eastland Hills Traffic update. Mr. Christopher advised the Supervisors have talked with Dennis Miller, a traffic engineer, regarding the problem with traffic in Eastland Hills and possible solutions. Mr. Joe Doyle and Mr. Stanley Sargent, residents of the area, commented on their concerns for this area.

5. Conditional Use 95-02 WTMA. Mr. Christopher advised that as requested by the WTMA, there will be a public hearing on this matter on April 3, 1995 at 7:30 p.m.

6. FORMAC Report: Mr. Christopher advised he attended a meeting of FORMAC, a group working to keep Fort Ritchie open. On Friday, March 25, 1995 people are being asked to be at center square of Waynesboro when a representative of the BRAC Committee travels from Letterkenny to Fort Ritchie. On a Dick/Diller motion, the Supervisors directed the Manager to proceed with FORMAC and do what ever is possible to show the Township's support of keeping Fort Ritchie open.

7. Transfer Station 1st Quarter Report. Mr. Christopher advised we have received a copy of DER's 1st Quarter inspection report. The Station was in compliance with a little housecleaning to be done.


8. Train Station Materials Bids. We received telephone quotes from Cavetown Planning Mill, Lumber Yard, and Lowe's of Chambersburg for the materials to build the train station at the Red Run Park. On a Diller/Dick motion, the Supervisors awarded the material bid to the low bidder, Lowe's of Chambersburg \$5,898.83. Vote was 3-0.
