RESOLUTION NO. 246

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS TOWNSHIP ESTABLISHING A POLICY FOR THE DISPOSAL OF ABANDONED AND/OR UNCLAIMED BICYCLES BY THE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, Act 248 of 1982, Section 1301.9, provides regulations for the disposition of abandoned and/or unclaimed property by the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Washington Township Police Department from time to time must dispose of abandoned and unclaimed bicycles; and

WHEREAS, the Washington Township Board of Supervisors believe the best way to dispose of these bicycles is to donate them to charity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of this Township, as follows:

- 1. That any abandoned and/or unclaimed bicycle in the possession of the Washington Township Police Department beyond 90 days from the date it was first recovered shall be deemed unclaimed by the Township.
- 2. The Washington Township Police Department, under the guidance of the Washington Township Police Chief, shall donate all unclaimed bicycles to a local non-profit or charitable organization for reuse where possible in the community.
