RESOLUTION NO. 248

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS TOWNSHIP
FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE TAX COLLECTOR
FOR COLLECTION OF THE REAL ESTATE TAX FOR
WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, once every four years, prior to the date set for gathering signatures on the petition of office of the Washington Township Tax Collector, the Board of Supervisors may change the compensation of said tax collector for collecting the real estate tax for the Township; and

WHEREAS, February 15, 1997, has been set as the deadline for setting the compensation for the Washington Township Tax Collector for the next four years; and

WHEREAS, the Washington Township Supervisors would like to set a compensation rate schedule for the collection of real estate taxes that varies with the millage rate of the Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of this Township, as follows:

- 1. The Washington Township Tax Collector's compensation for the next four years shall be paid on a percentage of tax revenue collected based on the following table:



1	5.00
2	5.00
3	5.00
4	5.00
5	5.00
6	4.50
7	4.25
8	4.00
9	3.75
10	3.50
11	3.25
12	3.00
13	2.75
14	2.50
15	2.25

- 2. If tax reform occurs, that results in the current tax collection system being restructured, then the compensation of the tax collector shall be restructured as well, according to the laws at that time.
- 3. This schedule shall take effect with the 1998 tax year.


