RESOLUTION NO. 257

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
THIS TOWNSHIP ESTABLISHING RULES AND
REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE PROCEDURE FOR THE
PUMPING OF SEPTIC TANKS IN THE TOWNSHIP**

WHEREAS, the Township of Washington, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, has established an Ordinance, Ordinance No. 145, that requires every property with a septic tank to have their septic tank pumped at least once every three years; and

WHEREAS, said Ordinance did not provide for any relief for property owners that pumped their tank the year before it was required; and

WHEREAS, Section 4 of Ordinance No. 145 provides for the adoption of rules and regulations concerning the pumping of on-lot sewage disposal septic tanks; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of this Township believe it is fair and reasonable to exempt from pumping individuals who pumped their septic system the year before it was required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, that the following procedures shall be followed for the pumping of septic tanks:

SECTION 1. EXEMPTIONS FROM PUMPING

The following properties shall be exempt from pumping their septic tank in their designated year:

- A. Properties designated to be pumped in 1998, if their septic tank was pumped in calendar year 1997.
- B. Properties designated to be pumped in 1999, if their septic tank was pumped in calendar year 1998.
- C. Properties designated to be pumped in 2000, if their septic tank was pumped in calendar year 1999.

SECTION 2. RESUMPTION OF REGULAR PUMPING SCHEDULE

Properties falling under the pumping exception in Section 1 shall have their septic tanks pumped again in the required year as listed below:


- A. Properties designated to be pumped in 1998, must be pumped again in 2001.

- B. Properties designated to be pumped in 1999, must be pumped again in 2002.
- C. Properties designated to be pumped in 2000, must be pumped again in 2003.
