RESOLUTION NO. 259

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
THIS TOWNSHIP ESTABLISHING RULES AND
REGULATIONS FOR CONDUCT IN AND THE USE OF "RED
RUN PARK" AND SUCH OTHER PARKS AS THE
SUPERVISORS OF WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP, FRANKLIN
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, SHALL, FROM TIME TO
TIME, ACQUIRE

WHEREAS, the Township of Washington, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, is the owner of a certain park commonly referred to as "Red Run Park" in the Township of Washington, Franklin County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, said Park was acquired by the Township of Washington, for the benefit and pleasure of the residents of the Township of Washington, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, and all persons who might use the same; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Washington, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, and such other persons who shall use the Park to benefit and have pleasure in the use and enjoyment of the Park deem it necessary to establish certain rules and regulations applicable to Red Run Park and such other parks as in the future may be acquired by the Township.

WHEREAS, the Washington Township Supervisors on May 20, 1996 adopted Resolution #236 which established Rules and Regulations for conduct in and the use of Red Run Park and such other parks in the Township; and

WHEREAS, from time to time the Township Supervisors may need to update and amend these rules and regulations to adapt to changes at the Township parks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, that the following rules and regulations shall be established for "Red Run Park" and such other parks as may, from time to time, be acquired by the Township:

SECTION 1. ACTS AND CONDUCT PROHIBITED

The following acts and conduct shall be prohibited:

- (A) Disorderly or immoral acts or practices.
- (B) Consumption of alcoholic beverages or the use of drugs, or being in the park in the state of intoxication, or under the influence of drugs.

- (C) The throwing of stones or similar missiles.
- (D) The use of profane, offensive, or indecent language.
- (E) No motor vehicle shall be parked in Red Run Park from sunset to sunrise, unless specifically authorized in writing by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors or his representative, except within areas specifically reserved for parking by the Board of Supervisors as marked by identification signs for such purposes.
- (F) No truck or truck tractor classified as a Class 6 or higher truck or truck tractor according to the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, or trailer drawn by a truck tractor, shall be parked within Red Run Park at any time, unless specifically authorized in writing by the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors or his representative.
- (G) Gambling or playing games of chance for money.
- (H) Begging and soliciting subscriptions.
- (I) Littering, throwing or depositing of papers, refuse and any offensive substances, except in receptacles provided therefore.
- (J) Sleeping within any park after hours, except at such places or times as may be designated in writing by the Chairman of the Board or his representative.
- (K) Pulling, injuring, breaking or digging of any flowers, fruits, plants, trees, grasses or turfs.
- (L) Breaking or defacing any bench, water fixture, trees, playground equipment, sanitary equipment, fixtures, or other structures.
- (M) Possess or discharge any firearms, air rifle, air pistol, sling shot, bows, fireworks, or other weapons, except police officers.
- (N) Driving any motor vehicle in the park to a speed in excess of five (5) miles per hour, or other than on the roadway provided for such purposes.
- (O) Bringing any animals, including dogs, except seeing eye dog or dog for the hearing impaired, or household pets on leash, to the park, except by written permission of the Chairman of the Board or his representative.

- (P) Defacing and mutilating any notices posted by the Board of Supervisors.
- (Q) Offering anything for sale, except by written permission of the Chairman of the Board or his representative.
- (R) Post or display any banner or poster of commercial or political nature except in special events authorized in writing by the Board of Supervisors or their representative.
- (S) Build any fire, except at places provided therefore.
- (T) Swimming in Red Run Lake, the lake spillway area, and all tributaries of Red Run stream in the park. Wading shall be permitted in the creek running into and out of the lake but not in the lake itself.
- (U) Capturing, harassment, injuring or killing of wildlife in the park, except fish.
- (V) No vehicles including motor vehicles or any type or description, as well as bicycles and tricycles, operated by human power, shall be driven within the park, except in those areas set aside as public roadways and for the parking of such vehicles.
- (W) No snowmobiles, mini bikes or motor driven vehicles of any type or description, unless properly licensed for highway use and bearing a current inspection permit shall be operated anywhere within the park, including public roadways and parking areas of said park.
- (X) Any dangerous practices and endangering the safety of others or self.
- (Y) The hitting of golf balls and the playing of golf.
- (Z) Any unlawful act.
- (AA) The parking of vehicles along the edge of East Avenue, T-807, except by written permission of the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors or his representative.
- (BB) The climbing of any building or onto roofs.
- (CC) Fishing at Red Run Lake when "No Fishing" signs have been posted by order of the Board of Supervisors or their representative.

SECTION 2. FACILITY RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- (A) Park pavilions may be used by all patrons except on days they are reserved.
- (B) Patrons using pavilions shall remove their trash and recyclables from the pavilion and place in the proper containers.
- (C) Bandstand may be used by all patrons except on days it is reserved by the Township.
- (D) Volleyball courts adjacent to Pavilions 2 and 3 may be used by all patron except when that pavilion is reserved.

SECTION 3. ENFORCEMENT. These rules and regulations may and shall be enforced under the authority of Ordinance No. 135 and under such other ordinances and laws as may, from time to time, be ordained by the Supervisors or enacted by the Commonwealth, respectively.

SECTION 4. RESCINDING OF PREVIOUS RESOLUTION. Resolution No. 236, adopted by the Board of Supervisors on May 20, 1996, is hereby rescinded by this resolution.


SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
