RESOLUTION # 264

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS TOWNSHIP REALLOCATING THE VOLUNTEER FIREMAN RELIEF ASSOCIATION FUNDS RECEIVED FROM THE COMMONWEALTH AS PER ACT 205 TO THE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP VOLUNTEER FIREMANS RELIEF ASSOCIATION.

WHEREAS, Act 205, The Municipal Pension Plan Funding Standards and Recovery Act of 1984 provides for an annual contribution from the Commonwealth to the Township for distribution to eligible relief associations;

WHEREAS, the Act requires that the Board of Supervisors by resolution, determine the amount of the contribution that shall be distributed to each eligible relief association; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors with Resolution # 133 established a split of these funds between the Washington Township Volunteer Firemans Relief Association and the Washington Township Volunteer Ambulance & Rescue Squad Relief Association; and

WHEREAS, the Blue Ridge Mountain Volunteer Fire Company No. 1 and the Blue Ridge Mountain Ambulance and Rescue Squad are planning to become one company; and

WHEREAS, the Blue Ridge Mountain Volunteer Fire Company No. 1 and the Blue Ridge Mountain Ambulance and Rescue Squad by letter dated October 19, 1998, requested the Township to allocate all the relief funds to the Washington Township Volunteer Firemans Relief Association.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors as follows:

1. The Township shall distribute 100% of the Commonwealth's allocation to the Washington Township Volunteer Firemans Relief Association.
2. Resolution # 133 is hereby rescinded.
