**OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS TOWNSHIP
ADOPTING THE 1999 WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP
COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE.**

WHEREAS, a comprehensive plan update for Washington Township, Franklin County, Pennsylvania, has been prepared by Martin & Martin, Inc., Planning Consultant, and presented to the Washington Township Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid comprehensive plan update was prepared by the Planning Consultant following extensive investigation, preparation, and consultation with the Washington Township Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid comprehensive plan update was recommended for approval by the Washington Township Planning Commission on November 9, 1998, and forwarded to the Washington Township Board of Supervisors for adoption; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to applicable provisions of law, notice of a public hearing for the purpose of receiving oral and written comments with respect to the comprehensive plan update has been properly published on January 11 and 18, 1999; and

WHEREAS, aforesaid public hearing having been held on February 1, 1999 where written and oral comments were received; and

WHEREAS, the Washington Township Board of Supervisors has duly deliberated with respect to the contents of the comprehensive plan update and the oral and written comments submitted with respect thereto.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of this Township, as follows:
