RESOLUTION NO. 275

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
THIS TOWNSHIP REVISING THE RULES AND
REGULATIONS FOR CONDUCT IN THE USE OF "RED RUN
PARK".**

WHEREAS, the Washington Township Supervisors adopted Ordinance 135 on May 20, 1996, which permits the establishment of rules and regulations by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Washington Township Supervisors adopted Resolution 236 on May 20, 1996 that established rules and regulations for the conduct in the use of Red Run Park; and

WHEREAS, from time to time, these rules and regulations need to be updated to reflect the current needs of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS TOWNSHIP, that the following rules and regulations amendments shall be added to Resolution No. 236:

SECTION 1. ACTS AND CONDUCT PROHIBITED:

(DD) Fishing off the handicapped ramp (if not handicapped) when a handicapped individual wants to fish.

In all other respects, Resolution # 236 shall remain in full force.
