RESOLUTION NO. 305

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THIS TOWNSHIP
RECOGNIZING BARRY ENSMINGER FOR HIS MANY YEARS OF

WHEREAS, BARRY ENSMINGER served as a member of the Washington Township Municipal Authority from November 20, 1978 to December 31, 1980 and again from November 21, 1988 until the expiration of his term on December 31, 2000; and

WHEREAS, during these fourteen years of service the Municipal Authority owned and operated sewer system was expanded many times to meet the needs of this Township, reached its capacity due to growth made possible by sewer and finally was upgraded to meet the future needs of the Township into the 21st century; and

WHEREAS, during this same period the public water system was designed, enlarged, upgraded to include fire protection, interconnected with each of the separate companies, and expanded many times; and

WHEREAS, BARRY ENSMINGER has played an integral part in these improvements and expansion by providing leadership and insight; and

WHEREAS, the Washington Township Board of Supervisors desire to recognize BARRY ENSMINGER for these many years of dedicated service with the Washington Township Municipal Authority.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of this Township that BARRY ENSMINGER is hereby recognized for his many years of dedicated service to the Washington Township Municipal Authority and to the Washington Township Community.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this Resolution be presented to BARRY ENSMINGER as further expression of appreciation of the Board of Supervisors.
