NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Councils and Mayors of the Boroughs of Waynesboro and Greencastle and the Supervisors of Washington Township, hereby urge the members of the Commonwealth's Senate and Assembly to support and enact enabling legislation which will permit local police departments to utilize radar and similar devices for the control of vehicular speeding. Further, we hereby direct the municipal Secretaries to forward a copy of this Resolution to the appropriate members of the Legislature.
